Remarks:

Horodenka is a town on the small river Yamgoriv, 75 km from [Ivano-Frankivsk](#). It was mentioned for the first time in 1195; in 1668 the town was granted the Magdeburg Law.

In the town of Horodenka, the buildings of the Great Synagogue and of another *beit midrash* are extant. The Jewish cemetery is partially preserved.
