Remarks:

Pistyn is a village on the Pistyn'ka river (a tributary of the Prut), 19 km from [Kolomea](#). It was mentioned for the first time in 1375, the Magdeburg law was granted in 1756 ([see here](#)). The Jewish cemetery in [Pistyn](#) was completely destroyed during the Soviet times, its tombstones were used as building material.
