



The Zionist Congress in Carlsbad, 1923




Figure 4. Presidium and executive of the World Zionist Organization at the Thirteenth Congress, Carlsbad, 1923. Seated in front row, left to right: Meir Berlin (Bar-Ilan), Chaim Weizmann, Shemaryahu Levin, Nahum Sokolow (chairman), Leo Motzkin, Louis Lipsky, Eliezer Kaplan, Yizhak Ben-Zvi. Courtesy J.N.U.L. Photo Collection, Jerusalem.




Postcard of 1905 Pogrom in Odessa










