## Lysiec - Rabbis

**Community:** Lysets

The first rabbis of Lysiec are unknown.

Apparently, Rabbi <u>Matityahu son of Dov Ber</u>, buried in the ohel in the <u>Lyciec cemetery</u>, served as the rabbi of the community until his death in 1831.

In the mid-nineteenth century there was a local Rabbi <u>Shaul Aharon</u>. His grandson Leibish received the right to sell alcohol in Lysiec (<u>Wunder</u>, 5:1).

Rabbi Menachem Mendel David was invited to Lysiec from Tlumach in 1869 (Pinkas Kehilot, p. 301).

In 1870, Rabbi <u>Yehudah Gershon son of Israel Yoel Pickholz</u> became the rabbi of Lysiec; he served the community till his death in 1912 (<u>Ohalei Shem, 250</u>; <u>Wunder, 4:66</u>; <u>his tombstone</u>).

After him the local rabbi was Rabbi Nahman, son of David Ha-Levi Hurvits.

He moved to Halich, and Rabbi <u>Efraim Fishel</u>, <u>son of David Hurvits</u> (probably his brother) became the rabbi of Lysiec (<u>Pinkas Kehilot</u>, p. 301).

In the 1920s the rabbi of Lysiec was Rabbi <u>Ben-Zion son of Shmuel Shapira</u> (1900-1941). However, he left to take his father's position as the rabbi of Złoczew in 1928 (<u>Wunder</u>, 5:456).

Among Lysiec Jews there were many *talmidei hakhamim*. On of them was Rabbi <u>Shlomo son of Yehoshua Schechter</u> (<u>Wunder</u>, 5:276).

Rabbi Mordechai from Lysiec was among the pupils of Rabbi <u>Tzvi Hirsch of Nadworna</u> (<u>Alfasi</u>, p. 250, no. 108).
